CART operates on regular schedule during fall and spring semesters at the University of Oklahoma; and alternate schedule all other times.

How to ride the bus

- Arrive at stop 5 minutes early and check bus route name before boarding.
- Keep aisles clear, allow seniors and those with disabilities to sit, and remain seated on bus.
- Pull signal cord one block ahead of stop location; check for personal items before leaving.
- Ask operator for assistance, call 325-2278, or visit <http://www.ou.edu/content/cart/howtoride.html> for more information.

Rules for riding the bus

- No smoking, eating or drinking on bus.
- Exact fare required; operators do not have change.
- Passengers must stand behind the white or yellow line at doors.
- No weapons are allowed on the bus.
- Limit parcels to 3 bags that can be secured in lap or on floor under feet
- Strollers and walkers must be folded, carried onto bus, and secured while riding.

Transfers

Passengers must ask operator for a transfer ticket when boarding the bus. Passengers will not receive a transfer when exiting the bus. The transfer is valid for one transfer within two hours. For more information, visit <http://www.ou.edu/content/cart/howtoride.html>.

CART transfer stations

CART operates two stations on the OU campus. All CART routes, except for the West Norman Link (20) operate out of one or both of these stations:

- Stop 107 - Brooks Street Station (Brooks, east of Jenkins in Duck Pond parking lot)
- Stop 1 - Campus Depot (Asp, north of Lindsey)

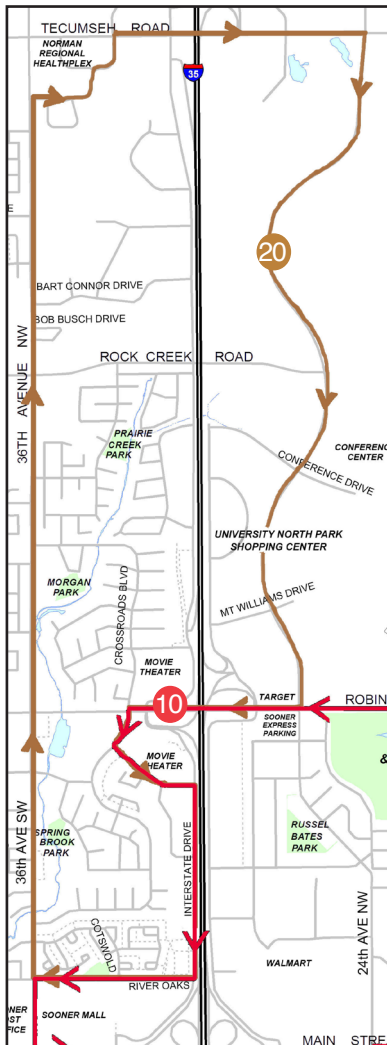

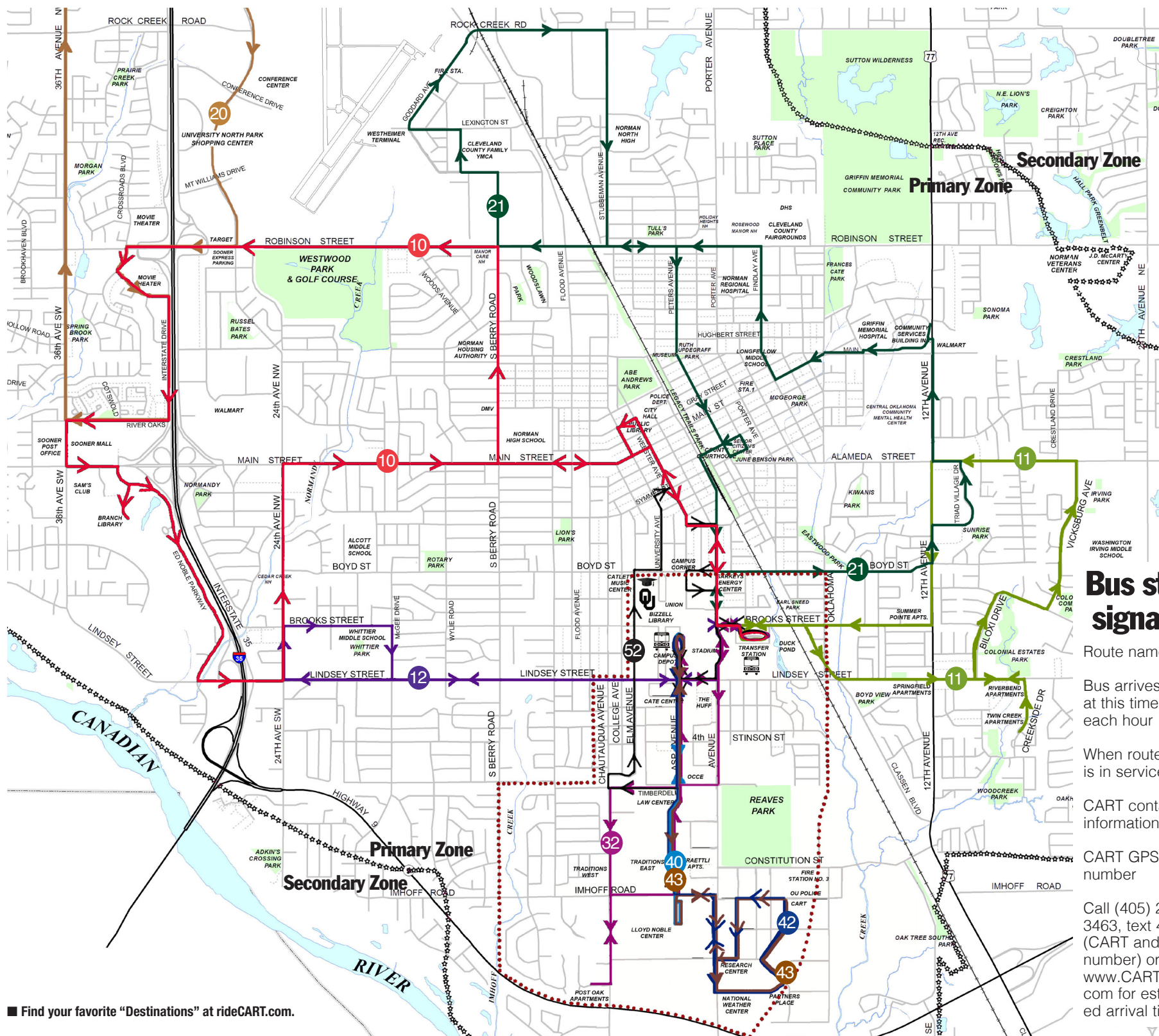

This route serves OU students, faculty and staff parking on the north side of the Lloyd Noble Center and riding to main campus. These CART passengers park permit-free. No fare is charged on this route.

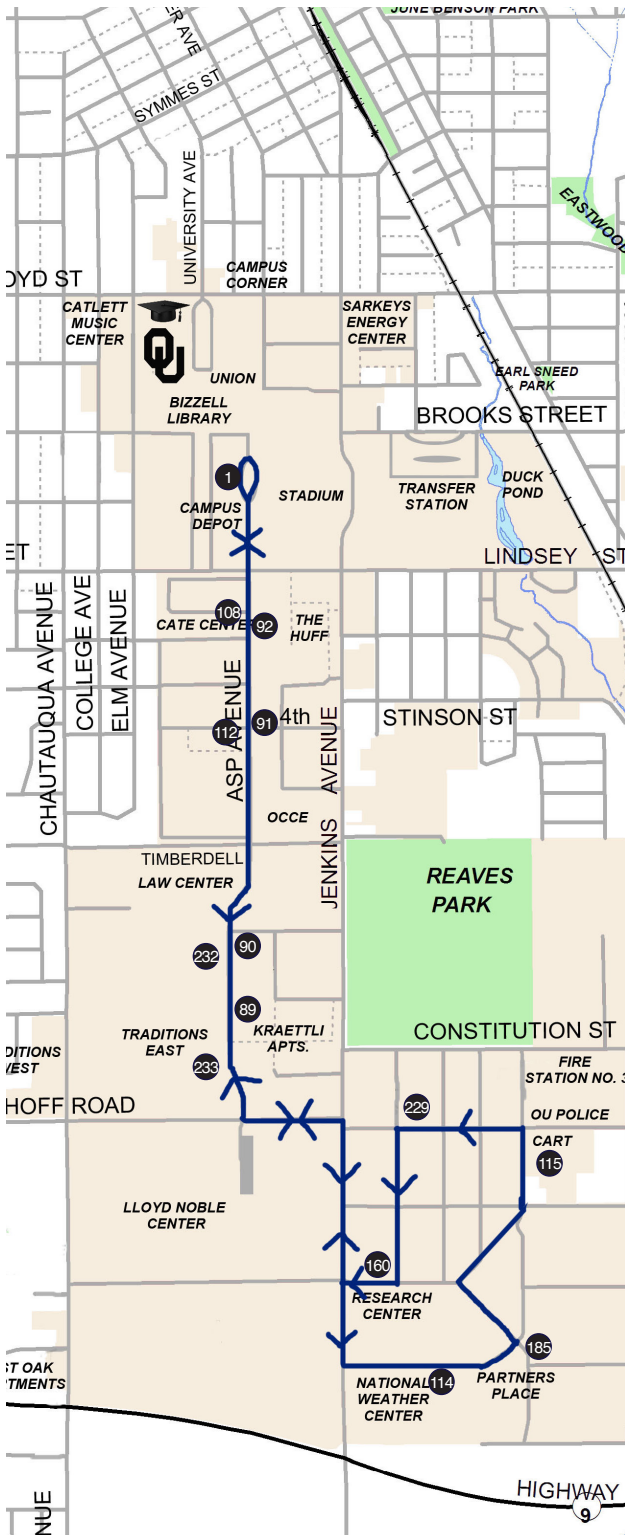

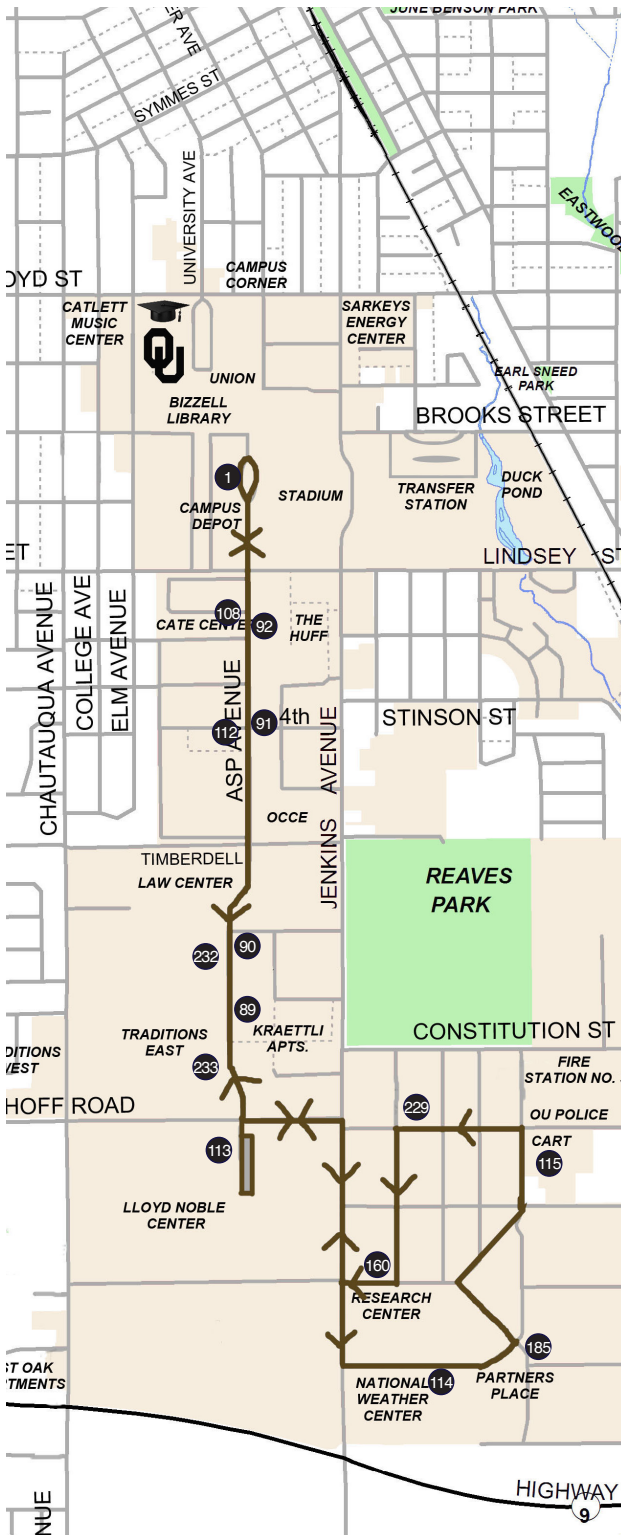

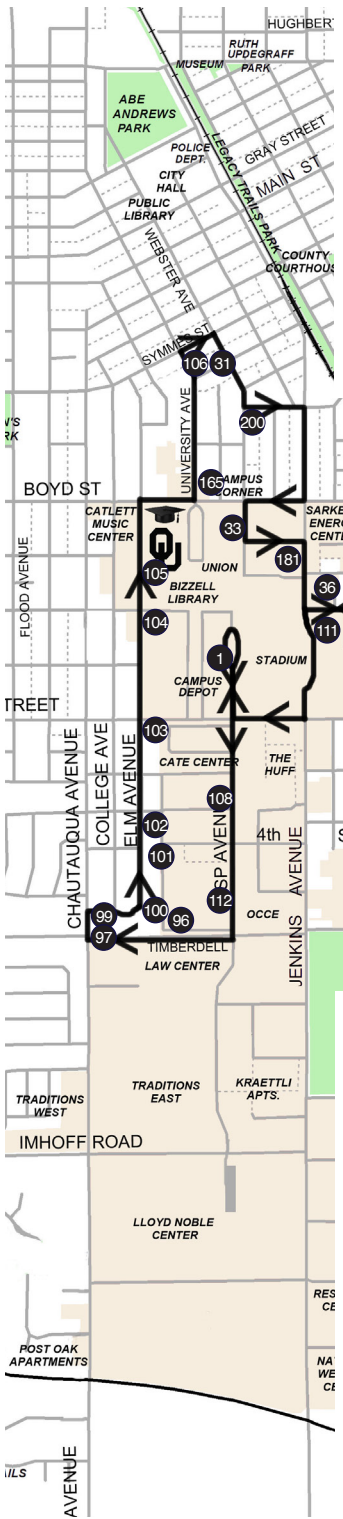
