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Artificial Intelligence and Machine Learning (AI/ML) comprise a large set of computational techniques for autonomous prediction and decision making, and for using data to automatically construct models that make these possible. In the last several years, the confluence of standardized tools and high-powered computational hardware have made the process of constructing new models, even from large data sets, possible for many science/engineering laboratories and organizations. This convergence is fundamentally changing the way that science and engineering are done in many domains. The goal of this symposium is to bring together AI/ML scientists and practitioners, high-performance computing experts, domain scientists and engineers from the OU campuses, and corporate partners to discuss 1) current and new AI/ML tools and their use in solving research and applied problems, and 2) new opportunities for collaboration. The meeting will also include representatives from local companies that are doing work in the AI/ML area and who are seeking new collaboration opportunities and new recruits.

We expect over 130 OU faculty, researchers, staff and students to participate in this year's symposium. We invite you to join us for this exciting event for its second year.
