Doctoral Program

The Gaylord College offers excellent funding for up to five students per year. The following two packages are highly competitive with offers of other programs around the country.

Gaylord Ph.D. Assistantships

- \$18-20,000 stipend per year for up to three years.
- Assistants will teach and do research for 20 hours per week during each academic year.
- Full tuition waiver for the chosen program
- Student health insurance ("Plan II") with the option of buying additional insurance for the fellow or dependents.
- Up to \$750 per year travel funds to present research

Gaylord Ph.D. Fellowships

- \$18-24,000 stipend per year for three years.
- Fellows will teach and do research for 20 hours per week during each academic year.
- Full waiver of tuition and partial or full waiver of course fees.
- Student health insurance ("Plan II") with the option of buying additional insurance for the fellow or dependents.
- Up to \$1,000 per year for travel to present research papers at conferences.

In addition, a limited number of competitive scholarships (\$500 - \$3,000) are available to all doctoral students every year.

Other funding opportunities may also be available. Students may seek assistance through the University Office of Financial Aid Services (www.ou.edu/financialaid) for federal loans and grants.
