

How to Sign up for the Health Insurance Marketplace

Enrollment for the Health Insurance Marketplace will open again on
November 15, 2015.

You can apply from November 15 to January 31.
Coverage can begin as soon as January 1, 2016.

You need these items to apply for coverage:

- Employer and income information for every member of your household who needs coverage (example: pay stubs or W-2)
- Social Security Numbers
- Birth Dates
- Policy numbers for any current health insurance plans
