At OU, we understand the importance of giving back. For that reason, we have an entire office on campus devoted to helping students find ways to serve our community.

The \$17.8 million renovation of the Norman campus student union includes a student leadership wing, allowing student organizations enhanced opportunities for cooperation and teamwork.

ENROLLMENT

The University of Oklahoma enrolls more than 30,000 students total on its campuses in Norman, Oklahoma City and Tulsa. There are, however, just over 20,000 undergraduate students on the Norman campus (one of the smaller student bodies in our conference). OU also offers courses throughout the state and around the world.

OU continues to attract the state's and nation's top students. In this year's full-time freshman class, the average ACT/SAT is 26. Also in this class, approximately one in 10 students graduated with a 4.0 high school grade point average.

OU is number one among all public institutions in National Merit Scholars enrolled, and there are over 700 National Merit Scholars enrolled at OU!

SCHOLARSHIPS & FINANCIAL AID

You can certainly reach your goal of becoming a Sooner because OU is committed to keeping the door of opportunity open for all qualified students.

OU's Campaign for Scholarships has passed the \$230 million mark, allowing the university to double scholarship assistance available to our students. Last year, more than two out of three OU students were awarded some type of financial assistance and the total amount of aid for those recipients was over \$240 million.
