Instructions for Spring Convocation Saturday, May 11, 2019 Lloyd Noble Center

Guest may enter the Lloyd Noble Center through the east doors. There will be no reserved seating. Specially designated areas will be available for those with disabilities.*

ACADEMIC REGALIA

Caps and gowns are required for those participating in the Price College Convocation ceremony. Students may order regalia online at ou.edu/commencement to be picked up at Graduation Gear-Up in Norman. Following Graduation Gear-Up events on March 18, students may go online at ou.edu/commencement to purchase regalia to be shipped directly to them. A shipping and handling fee will be charged.

CONVOCATION DETAILS

Convocation for Price College will be held in the Lloyd Noble Center at the University of Oklahoma on Saturday, May 11, 2019 at 8:00 a.m. All students should report to the practice gyms on the south side of the lower level of Lloyd Noble Center in the south tunnels no later than 7:15 a.m. Graduates and Undergraduates will gather in separate gyms that will be clearly marked.

The processional up the ramp into Lloyd Noble Center will begin promptly at 8:00 a.m. The order of the processional will be: Price College deans, Price College faculty, flag & banner carriers, PhD candidates, master's candidates and undergraduate candidates. During the processional all candidates should remain standing until everyone has reached their seats. Once seated, make sure the information card you will be given is complete before going to the stage. Special recognition will be given to those graduates whose parents, grandparents and great-grandparents are alumni of the University of Oklahoma.

Follow the instructions from your Faculty Marshals. They will let you know when to proceed to the stage. Present your card to the individual announcing the names, proceed across the stage to receive your diploma cover from the dean and return to your seat. All graduates are required to stay in their seats throughout the remainder of the ceremony.

Guests should not leave their seats to photograph students during the ceremony. There will be opportunities after the ceremony for guests to come forward and take pictures. A professional photographer will take a picture of each graduate receiving his/her diploma. This service is provided at no charge to the graduate and a proof will be mailed to you after Convocation. There is no obligation to purchase these photos. If you have any questions regarding official photographs, please call Party Pics at (405) 364-1777.

All guests and graduates entering the building will be screened by metal detectors.

DIPLOMAS

Approximately twelve weeks after Convocation, the Office of Admissions and Records will mail diplomas to those candidates who have been cleared for graduation. Requests for transcripts must be made in writing to the Office of Admissions and Records. There is no charge for an official transcript.
