

Accelerated Dual-Degree Program How to apply?

Application Information

- Apply by August 15th prior to your senior year
 - o ISE Application Form
 - o Official GRE score sheet (gre.org)
 - Statement of Purpose
 - o Resume/Vita
 - o 3 letters of recommendation from Faculty/Instructors at OU (2 must be from IE Faculty)
- You can obtain an application by visiting the School of ISE website, or by picking one up from the ISE Faculty
 office, located in CEC 116

Undergraduate Student Requirements

- OU retention GPA must be a 3.25 at time of application
- Maintain undergraduate advisor until your B.S. is posted
- Students accepted into the program can use four professional elective courses (i.e., twelve credit hours) to simultaneously satisfy the requirements of both the BS and MS degrees. Six out of the twelve credit hours must be the following:
 - o Fall senior year enroll in ISE 5383 (Systems Evaluation)
 - o Fall senior year enroll in ISE 5853 (Data-Driven Decision Making II)
- By April 15th of your senior year you must identify your thesis advisor, and apply to the Graduate College

Graduate Student Requirements

- The OU Graduate College monitors your GPA and you must maintain a 3.25 to be admitted into the OU Graduate College as an ISE Accelerated Student and throughout your graduate school experience.
- File a *Plan of Study* with the ISE student services coordinator by **April 15**th of your senior year. The *Plan of Study* must be approved by your ISE Thesis Advisor, Committee, and the Graduate Liaison
- File the Admission to Candidacy Form/Program of Graduate Work and the Application for Approval of the Master's Thesis Topic and Committee Membership Form two full weeks prior to the Graduate College deadlines with the student services coordinator.

Graduate College deadlines are as follows:

- o The first Monday in March (for summer graduation)
- o The first Monday in April (for fall graduation)
- The first Monday in October (for spring graduation)
- File an Application for Graduation and Permanent Alumni Record Information with Academic Records according to their deadlines of:
 - October 1st (for fall graduation)
 - March 1st (for spring graduation)
 - July 1st (for summer graduation)

A photo copy of this information is also due to the ISE student services coordinator by the above indicated deadlines.

Note: Acceptance into the Accelerated BS/MS Program does not guarantee admission to the Graduate College upon graduation with the BS Degree. Prior to acceptance into the ISE Graduate Program, students must meet the criteria for the GRE, submit letters of reference, and continue to meet GPA requirements. Final acceptance to the graduate program is subject to approval of the ISE Graduate Review Committee and the Dean of the Graduate College.

Program Description

An accelerated five-year dual-degree program that results in the award of two degrees:

- o BS in Industrial and Systems Engineering / MS in Industrial and Systems Engineering (A525 / F525), or
- o BS in Industrial and Systems Engineering IT Option / MS in Industrial and Systems Engineering (A526 / F526)

Minimum Admission Requirements

- Undergraduate OU student majoring in Industrial and Systems Engineering
- OU retention GPA and combined retention GPA of 3.25 or above
- Completed at least 12 credit hours of ISE courses at OU (including ISE 4223, 4563, 4633, and 4804)

Application Materials – Due by August 15th prior to your senior year

- ISE Application form
- Official GRE score sheet (gre.org)
- Statement of Purpose
- Resume/Vita
- Three (3) letters of recommendation from Faculty/Instructors at OU (Two (2) must be from ISE faculty)
