Convocation is a formal ceremony for Gallogly College of Engineering Bachelor of Science, Master of Science, and Doctor of Philosophy graduates and their guests. **The Gallogly College of Engineering Convocation will be held McCasland Field House, 151 E. Brooks St., Norman, OK on Saturday, May 17, 1:30 p.m.** Degree candidates and graduates from Fall 2022 and Summer 2022 in the Fall 2022 Convocation. All participating graduates need to arrive by **12:30 p.m.** for check-in and to line up for the processional. Each graduate is recognized and photographed with the Dean as his/her name is announced. UNDERDUATE STUDENTS (B.S.)

B.S. graduates from Fall 2022 and Summer 2022 may participate in the Fall 2022 Convocation. Please advise your WSSC advisor that you wish to participate. WSSC will work with all undergraduate students to check that they are eligible for graduation, typically in the prior semester.

Convocation information will be available to pick up in WSSC in September and at Graduation Gear Up in October. This information includes an OU Commencement invitation, a GCoE Convocation invitation, and other graduation related information. All graduates and candidates should **apply for graduation** by **September 15**. This will ensure that you are included in any emails regarding Commencement, Convocation, or other events or information related to graduation. Students can apply for graduation on One.

CAP & GOWN

All graduates participating in Commencement and Convocation must wear their cap and gown. You may purchase these and other graduation related items during Graduation Gear Up in late September at the Molly Shi Boren Ballroom at the Oklahoma Memorial Union. OU-Tulsa and Health Sciences Center students will have the opportunity to purchase regalia (no need to pre-order) at the Graduation Gear up events held in Tulsa and OKC. After Graduation Gear-Up, students may purchase regalia and other graduation items on-campus at The Sooner Shop. Students can also order online at Josten's Online Shop (https://www.jostens.com/apps/store/customer/1047222/University-of-Oklahoma) by November 3 by 5:00pm. If ordered online, a shipping and handling fee of \$12.95 will be charged.

ACADEMIC DISTINCTION

You will be notified by OU e-mail if you are eligible to receive academic distinction from the Gallogly College of Engineering. If you receive this distinction, you are eligible to wear specially designated hoods over your academic regalia. Once notified, you may purchase your hood during Graduation Gear-Up, the Sooner Shop, or through Josten's Online Shop. There is a fee (not including sales tax) to purchase the academic distinction or honors recognition hood. Students receiving honors distinction will be notified by the Honors College.

4.0 GRADE POINT RECOGNITION

Students will receive an invitation about a special event hosted by President Harroz. You are also eligible to wear specially designated academic distinction hoods. WHEN AND WHERE TO REPORT ON CONVOCATION DAY

Graduates/candidates should report to <u>Wagner Hall by 12:30 p.m.</u> to line up for the processional. Look for your major and check in with the staff volunteer for your program. Upon check-in, you will be given a lapel pin to wear during the ceremony and a name card that you will complete prior to the ceremony and hand to the announcer before crossing the stage.

Stay in your lines and listen for instructions for the processional. You will be seated by school or program. All graduates/candidates must remain in the seating area until the ceremony is concluded. **Do not bring purses or umbrellas.**

GUEST INFORMATION AND LIVESTREAM

Family, friends, and guests are invited to the Fall Convocation. No tickets are required. A sign language interpreter will be present at the ceremony and special seating will be designated for guests that will utilize this service.

Our Convocation will be livestreamed over YouTube. A link will be provided on the <u>Commencement website</u> closer to the day of the ceremony. The livestream will be captioned. An archive link will be made available after the ceremony on the Commencement website.

PHOTOGRAPHS

<u>Guests, please do not go onto the floor to take photographs</u>. Professional photographs of each graduate will be taken as he/she is introduced. Individual photos will also be taken. This service is provided at no charge to the graduate. A complimentary color proof will be mailed to you after Convocation. There will be no additional solicitation. DIPLOMAS AND OFFICIAL TRANSCRIPTS

Approximately fifteen weeks after your final semester, the Office of Admissions and Records will mail diplomas to degree candidates who have been cleared for graduation. All tuition and fees must be paid to the University, or a hold will be placed on your diploma. It is the responsibility of the student to contact the Office of Admissions and Records to request your diploma once the fees have been paid.

For those requesting transcripts, the request must be made in person to the Office of Admissions and Records at least ten weeks after the semester has ended. There is no charge for official transcripts. All tuition and fees must be paid to the University, or a hold will be placed on your transcript. It is the responsibility of the student to contact the Office of Admissions and Records to request your transcript once the fees have been paid.
