

- 1. Description of Program
- The Graduate Student Research Fellows Program aims to facilitate networking and interdisciplinary collaborations, support social justice research by providing a platform for feedback, create a space where new social justice research projects can be discussed and promoted, and serve as a venue to find partners in research.
- Areas of interest include environmental justice, socioeconomic justice, political philosophy, gender justice, criminal justice, civic engagement, social dialogue, media activism, social stratification, and many more subjects.
- 2. Criteria and Application Instructions
- Applicants must be a graduate student at the University of Oklahoma. New applicants will need to submit a CV, a brief endorsement from their advisor or graduate liaison and a statement of research interests and how they relate to social justice.
- Monthly attendance to GSRF meetings is required. The meetings may include presentations by one of the fellows, workshops on particular issues relevant to the fellows, brown bags and speaker series.
- Fellows also give back to the OU community through working with student groups, classes and departments. Giving back to the community is an important part of the Center's mission to inspire and involve students in social justice issues.
