OU-Tulsa offers a loan forgiveness program for students majoring in Early Childhood Education with certification from birth to third grade. The program provides an in-state tuition waiver from the University of Oklahoma for required early childhood education courses taken at OU-Tulsa. The George Kaiser Family Foundation (GKFF) loan forgiveness program covers fees and books for both half and full-time study through program completion.

Our program is structured so that for each year of full-time work after graduation, in any licensed early childhood facility or accredited school in Oklahoma, public or private, the GKFF loan is reduced by 25%. Therefore, the loan is forgiven in full after four years of teaching.



All students who are admitted to the OU-Tulsa early childhood education program are eligible to participate in the GKFF loan forgiveness program.

PROGRAM FEATURES

- Study your first two years at Tulsa Community College or another institution
- Full in-state tuition waiver from OU
- Loan forgiveness for books & fees from the GKFF by working with children in licensed facilities or accredited schools in Oklahoma for four years
- The bachelors degree can be completed in two years
- All courses held in Tulsa on campus at 41st & Yale
- Individual attention from four full-time Tulsa based faculty and small class sizes
- Certification in early childhood for teaching infants through third grade
- Designed for the working adult offering full and part-time study in evening and occasional weekend classes
