The challenge of the curriculum or personal issues may be overwhelming at times. The program faculty are available to provide educational guidance as students progress through the program. Students are encouraged to seek support through their faculty advisor or another faculty member at any time during the program. Students may be referred for additional support when the needs extend beyond the scope of the faculty.

Counseling can help students manage stress, adjust to new academic demands, identify problems through assessment and testing, establish healthy problem-solving strategies, deal with grief, and develop and improve healthy relationships. The Student Success Program provides an avenue to recognize strengths and offer supplemental support for PA and medical students at the OU-TU School of Community Medicine in Tulsa. The goal of the Student Success Program is not only to provide support for students' academic advancement but to offer support for holistic development.
