- a. Public Safety with OU PD Introduction of Major Joshua Lee who is our new Interim Deputy Chief. Provided an update on safety tips for tornados.
 - i. Explanation of the difference between a watch (possible) and a warning (need to take action).

- b. This is a check-in survey with only 5 questions on it.
- c. Please watch your email. Some have been going to junk folders, so if you have not received one, please check there.
- d. Reminders will be going out on Monday, Wednesday, and Friday.
- e. Shared the website for results where you can see updated results. You can see it by campus. Tulsa is doing well with 44%, but they would like to see more.
- f. Results are shown in multiple areas: employee group, hourly staff, faculty, college office, etc.
- g. If you did not get the email, there is a link you can use. It requires you knowing your Employee ID but it is best to just search for the email that was sent to you.
- h. Keep in mind the intent behind it. "Has anyone talked to you about engagement?" "Has anybody discussed the results of the 2024 engagement survey with you?"
- i. The intent is that each manager, each leader, each senior leader, each executive leader look at their survey results and work with their teams and pick one item, to work on, build an action plan around, and develop goals around it.
