Dropping a Course

Below is the process if you want to drop a course after Jan 31:

1. Pick up a **drop slip** from either University College or the Office of Registration.
2. Obtain an **advisor's signature** at University College. You do not have to make an appointment.
3. Take slip to the Office of **Registration** to process.
4. Deadline for an automatic W is **February 25**.

Remember, there is **no refund** for any dropped courses after **January 31**.

Dates and Deadlines

January 31: Last day to drop with a full **refund**

February 25: Last day to drop with an automatic grade of **W**

April 1: Last day to drop with instructor's signature of a **W or F**

April 4 – May 6: Students must **petition** Dean to drop a course

May 6: Last day to **completely withdraw** from all courses
