Appointments can only be made up to **2 weeks** in advance. It will indicate no available appointments, if we are **full** up to that point. Check each morning for a new set of open appointments. However, you can be advised anytime before your enrollment window opens on Ozone.

## Dropping a Course

Starting **Feb 28**, below is the process if you want to drop a course:

1. Pick up a **withdrawal slip** from either University College or the Office of Registration.
2. Obtain an **instructor's signature** of **W or F**.
3. Bring slip to University College to be signed by an **advisor**. You do not have to make an appointment.
4. Take slip to the Office of **Registration** to process.
5. Deadline is **April 1** (10th week).

Remember, there is **no refund** for any dropped courses after **January 31**.

## Dates and Deadlines

**April 1:** Last day to drop with instructor's signature of a **W or F**

**April 4 – May 6:** Students must **petition** Dean to drop a course

**May 6:** Last day to **completely withdraw** from all courses
