Advising for Spring

Appointments can be made up to **2 weeks** in advance at iadvise.ou.edu

If no appointments show available, then it is full up to 2 weeks. Keep checking early each morning for a new set of appointments.

There are possibilities of walk-in appointments if there are any no-shows. Check about this at the front desk of UC. If a student is more than 5 minutes late, we will take a walk-in.

You can be advised anytime before your **enrollment window** opens on **Ozone.ou.edu**. Under the Academics tab, click on "Enrollment Window and Registration Status."

Dates and Deadlines

Nov 1 - Dec 10: Students must **petition** Dean to drop a course

If you petition, you must have extenuating circumstances beyond your control and provide documentation to be approved. You can pick up information about petitioning at the front desk of University College. It will not be approved if you are just making a low grade in the course.

December 10: Last day to **completely withdraw** from all courses
