

Calculate Your GPA – Grade Point Average

Directions: The following tables are examples for you to reference. Follow the steps to fill in the blank table provided.

Step 1. List all your courses for the semester, including the course numbers.

Step 2. Look at the last number in each course – this is the number of hours your course is worth. List these numbers in the credit hours column.

Step 3. Referencing the Letter Grade table, list the letter grades you have earned (or estimate to earn) for each course.

Step 4. Multiply the credit hours by the letter grade value for each course. These are the Quality Points for the course.

Step 5. Add up the total number of credit hours you are taking this semester. Add up the total number of quality points for the semester.

Step 6. Divide the total number of Quality Points by the total number of Credit Hours. This is your GPA for the semester.
