

GRADUATE FOREIGN LANGUAGE READING EXAM (GFLRE)

APPLICATION AND INSTRUCTIONS

GENERAL NOTE TO STUDENT: Examination will be a translation of a passage approved by the examiner from a submission from a book or journal that the student submits for review.

PROCEDURES:

- 1.) Select a book or journal in your field in the language in which you are to be tested. The book or journal must be at least 80 pages in length. The text submitted must be a secondary source. Only critical articles, journal, monographs and books will be accepted. Other types of non-fiction are unacceptable. Works of fiction such as novels and short stories are unacceptable. Additionally, the text must have been originally written and published in the foreign language to be tested. Unacceptable texts will be returned to you with a request to resubmit an appropriate text.
- 2.) Complete the "student information" section of the GFLRE application and submit it along with your book or journal to the Modern Learning Languages Lab (MLLL) in Kaufman Hall, Room 206.
- 3.) MLLL will appoint your examiner.
- 4.) Upon approval of the book or journal, the examiner will forward the application and a copy of the passage of approximately 400 words to be translated to the OU Testing Center located at 300 Kellogg Drive (Boomer Outreach Building), Room 140. The OU Testing Center phone number is 405-325-1921 and email is testing@ou.edu.
- 5.) MLLL will notify you to come and pick up the original book and tell student to go ahead and schedule.
- 6.) The exam is proctored at the OU Testing Center and student will pay \$75 and schedule here:

- 7.) You will have two hours to complete the exam and you can bring your own dictionary if you wish. Please check with the OU Testing Center to see if they have one in the language you are testing.
- 8.) The OU Testing Center will scan email the exam back to appointed examiner and once complete, the results are reported to you, the student, and any additional persons or departments that you specify in the "student information" section by the MLLL.
