To Whom It May Concern:

The Bachelor of Science in Aviation programs require **SCM 3113 Principles of Supply Chain Management**, which is a major support requirement on the degree check sheet in the OU General Catalog.

For students under the **2023 catalog and later**, it is recognized that the following courses—*SCM 3523 Production/Operations Management*, *SCM 3223 Logistics Management*, or *SCM 3123 Procurement and Strategic Sourcing*—cover substantial portions of the same foundational supply chain concepts.

If a student has already completed one of these alternative SCM courses, academic advisors have blanket permission to adjust the degree audit **to accept that course in place of SCM 3113**.

Advisors will document this adjustment by creating a substitution within the student's degree audit, ensuring that all students complete the necessary instruction in supply chain management while maintaining accurate degree records.

Upon approval and signature, this document will serve as the standing guideline for applying these course substitutions to all eligible student records. The finalized memorandum will be archived in Laserfiche to ensure secure access, proper documentation, and long-term institutional consistency.
