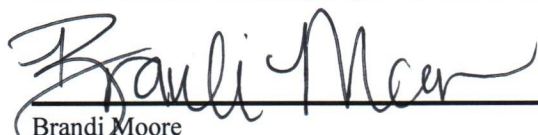
To Whom It May Concern:

The Bachelor of Science in Aviation- Aviation Management Non-flying program requires **SCM 3123 Procurement and Strategic Sourcing**, which is a major support requirement on the degree check sheet in the OU General Catalog.

For students under the **2026 catalog and later, it is recognized that *SCM 3113 Principles of Supply Chain Management* is now the designated course substitution for this requirement.** However, in situations where a student is unable to enroll in SCM 3113 due to scheduling conflicts or course availability issues, *SCM 3223 Logistics Management* or *SCM 3523 Production/Operations Management* may be used as an approved alternative substitution, as these courses cover substantial portions of the foundational supply chain management concepts addressed by the requirement.

Advisors will document this adjustment by creating a substitution within the student's degree audit, ensuring that all students complete the necessary instruction in supply chain management while maintaining accurate degree records.

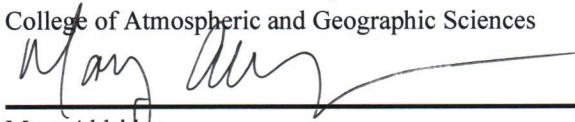
