To Whom It May Concern:

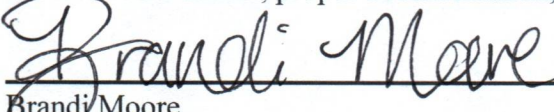
The Bachelor of Science in Meteorology requires students to complete 3 credit hours of an upper-level statistics course. The options for students currently are either *METR 3323 Statistical Meteorology* or *MATH 4753 Applied Statistical Methods*.

METR 3323 Statistical Meteorology went through a curriculum change and is now METR 4313 Statistical Meteorology. While the course had approval to be updated, the Meteorology checksheet was not updated accordingly.

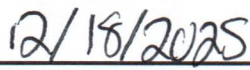
Therefore, students who complete METR 4313 Statistical Meteorology have blanket permission to utilize that course in place of METR 3323 Statistical Meteorology.

Advisors will document this adjustment by creating a substitution within the student's degree audit, ensuring that all students complete the necessary instruction while maintaining accurate degree records.

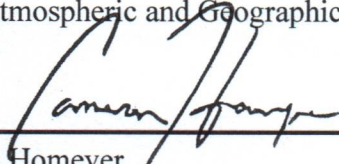

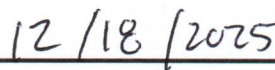
