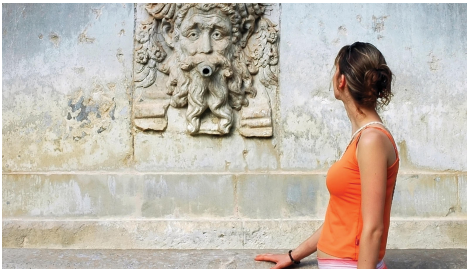

Day 1: Travel day

Day 2: Arrival in Barcelona

Included meals: Dinner

Welcome to Barcelona! Transfer to your hotel and enjoy a free afternoon at your leisure before meeting your fellow travelers at tonight's welcome dinner.

Day 3: Sightseeing tour of Barcelona

Discover why the Catalan capital is touted for its unparalleled architectural landmarks, many of which are UNESCO World Heritage sites.

- Step inside La Sagrada Família, Gaudí's famous masterwork-in-progress
 - Drive along Passeig de Gràcia, past Gaudí's "House of Bones"
 - Stop at Montjuïc, site of the 1992 Olympic Games took place, and take in the panoramic views at Mirador de l'Alcalde Park
 - Pass Plaça d'Espanya, one of the city's most important squares, and stroll past the soaring Columbus Monument, dedicated to the legendary explorer
- Then, take the afternoon to explore the city on your own or add an excursion.

Day 3: Park Güell & La Pedrera | \$85* (4 hours, departure time varies)

Discover the magnificent works of Antoni Gaudí, the famed Spanish architect known for his bold, distinct designs. Take a guided tour of Casa Milà, popularly known as La Pedrera, built by Gaudí between 1905 and 1910. Everything about the building is visually unique, from the wave-like stone structure and grandly designed roof to the apartment that reflects the style of the 20th-century bourgeoisie. Next, you'll head to Park Güell, also designed by Gaudí. Your guide will lead you through the park, which contains stunning buildings, intricate stonework and colorful mosaics. At the top of the park, marvel at the brilliant views of Barcelona. *This excursion requires advance reservation and must be booked by 20 days prior to departure.*

Day 4: Picasso & Gothic Barcelona | \$65/\$75* (4 hours, departs in the morning)

On today's excursion, visit Barcelona's Picasso Museum. You'll also venture to the Gothic Quarter, home to the city's massive cathedral. Commonly referred to as La Seu, the Cathedral de la Santa Creu i Santa Eulàlia (named after the city's patron saint), opens its doors to you on this excursion.

Day 5: Montserrat & Cava Cellars | \$79/\$89* (8 hours, departs in the morning)

Step outside Barcelona this morning on a journey to the Santa Maria de Montserrat Abbey, located about an hour north of the city. After a guided tour, you'll be free to explore this mountainous enclave on your own. You may have a chance to visit La Moreneta, Catalonia's miraculous and beloved statue of the Black Virgin of Montserrat. Or, ride the St. Joan cable car to the heights of Montserrat, where you'll find sweeping views of Catalonia. If you're lucky, you may be able to hear a performance of L'Escolania, the boys' choir that practices daily at the abbey. Later, drive to cava wine country. You'll descend into a wine cellar to learn about the production of cava and taste the sparkling white wine for which Spain is famous. Please note: Due to the ever-changing schedule of church activities, a viewing of the Black Virgin of Montserrat statue cannot be guaranteed.

Extension optional excursion

Day 6: Figueres & the Dalí Theatre-Museum | \$89* (6 hours, departs in the morning)

Venture north of Barcelona for a visit to Figueres, the hometown of Salvador Dalí. Take a guided tour of the Dalí Theatre-Museum, viewing a collection of the artist's works housed in the town's former municipal theatre.

This is the largest single collection of Dalí's works anywhere, and the artist himself is buried in a crypt beneath the museum. Afterward, stroll around the artist's hometown to learn more about where he was born and what his everyday life was like. Enjoy some free time here for lunch before departure. *This excursion requires advance reservation and must be booked by 20 days prior to departure.*

*Optional excursions may be purchased up to 3 days prior to departure or while on tour. Pre-purchased optional excursions cannot be canceled within 3 days prior to departure or while on tour. Select optional excursions require advance booking and cannot be purchased or canceled after the advanced reservation deadline.
