Overnight Flight | 1 night

Day 1: Travel day

Board your overnight flight to London today.

London | 4 nights

Day 2: Arrival in London

Included meals: Dinner

Welcome to London! Meet your fellow travelers at tonight's welcome dinner.

Day 3: Sightseeing tour of London

Included meals: Breakfast

Take a guided tour of the regal landmarks of the English capital with a local expert leading the way.

- Pass the grand Trafalgar Square and Baroque-style St. Paul's Cathedral, perched atop Ludgate Hill
- \bullet See Westminster Abbey, the setting for royal coronations and weddings

Day 7: Sightseeing tour of Paris

A guided tour introduces you to the architecture, scenery and history of the City of Light's many neighborhoods, called *arrondissements*.

- Pass Pont Neuf and the legendary Notre-Dame Cathedral, located on an island in the Seine River
- See the Eiffel Tower, the Palais Garnier opera house and Place de la Concorde, the city's grandest square
- Marvel at the iconic architecture of the Louvre and Hôtel des Invalides Enjoy a free afternoon in Paris or add an excursion. (It may be offered on day 8, depending on the day of the week.)

Day 3: Windsor Castle | \$99* (5 hours, departs in the afternoon)

Led by a Blue Badge Guide, you'll travel to Windsor for a guided tour of the world's largest and longest inhabited castle. Founded by William the Conqueror in 1070, Windsor has been the British Royal Family's preferred retreat for the past 900 years. Step inside the State Apartments and St. George's Chapel, where the Knights of the Garter ceremony takes place. View the exhibit of royal treasures on display within the castle. You'll then have time to stroll through the town of Windsor and have a look at Eton College, a prestigious prep school attended by Princes William and Harry. Please note: Windsor Castle is occasionally closed when in use by the Royal Family; a visit to Henry VIII's Hampton Court will be substituted when necessary. Additionally, St. George's Chapel is closed to the public on Sundays. This excursion requires advance reservation and must be booked by 20 days prior to departure.

Day 4: Stonehenge & Oxford \mid \$125* (9.5 hours,

departs in the morning)

Pay a visit to Oxford, home to one of the oldest and most prestigious universities in the world. You'll take in the charming city's famous spire-studded architecture and learn more about its academic legacy during a visit to Christ Church. This iconic landmark serves as both a cathedral and one of the most famous colleges in Oxford, and you'll discover its extensive history during your visit. Then, step inside the world-renowned Oxford University before taking free time for lunch. Next, continue on to Stonehenge, perhaps England's most mysterious landmark. The origin and purpose of this ring of stones, which dates back an estimated 5,000 years, is unknown, though most believe it was a temple and observatory. Take some time to explore the intriguing stone formations and visit the newly opened exhibition and visitor center before heading back to London. This excursion requires advance reservation and must be booked by 20 days prior to departure.

Day 5: Tower of London & Thames River Cruise

\$119* (6 hours, departs in the morning)

Enter the Tower of London, a UNESCO World Heritage site famous for its dark history of treason, imprisonment, and beheadings. With a local blue-badge guide leading the way, you'll explore the nooks and crannies of this royal castle, seeing ancient coin collections, suits of armor, and the glittering Crown Jewels as you go. Later, step aboard a riverboat for a cruise down the Thames and take in views of the London skyline, Tower Bridge, Southbank, and more from the water. Please Note: This excursion requires advance reservation and must be booked at least 20 days prior to departure. Day 5: London Eye & Pub Dinner | \$125* (5 hours, evening with dinner)

Glide through London's skyline on the London Eye. As the world's third-tallest observation wheel, the London Eye lifts its passengers 450 feet above the River Thames on a 30-minute ride in an enclosed gondola. In clear weather, you can see for 25 miles around the city center. Afterward, take a brief tour of London's West End before venturing to a local pub for dinner. This excursion requires advance reservation and must be booked by 20 days prior to departure.

Day 6: Dinner in Paris & Seine River Cruise

\$115/\$125* (5 hours, evening with dinner)

Take in the nighttime allure of the City of Light on a special evening excursion. The event begins with dinner at a local restaurant. After you dine, board a boat cruise along the Seine. As you coast along the river and under Paris' bridges, you'll behold the illuminated monuments of the city glittering alongside the riverbanks. Please note: The dress code may vary depending on the restaurant for your dinner. Your Tour Director will advise you on what to wear, but shorts and sneakers are likely to be considered inappropriate attire.

Day 7: Versailles Palace & Gardens | \$115* (5

hours, departure time varies)

The reign of Louis XIV, known as the "Sun King," set new standards for decadence among the crowned heads of Europe. It took 50 years and 35,000 workers to turn Versailles, once a small hunting lodge, into the most magnificent château in all of France and the envy of royalty worldwide. On this excursion, you will see the palace in all its glory as you tour the State Apartments and the glittering Hall of Mirrors. Then, stroll through the lavish gardens to admire their fine statuary, splendid fountains, and colorful flowerbeds. Please note: The four rooms of the Queen's State Apartment are closed for renovations through 2017. This excursion requires advance reservation and must be booked by 45 days prior to departure.

Day 8: Monet & the Landscapes of Giverny \mid

\$85/\$95* (6 hours, departs in the morning)

The village of Giverny was home to Claude Monet from 1883 until his death in 1926. On a visit to Monet's home and gardens, discover the subtle palette of colors that inspired his Water Lilies series and gave rise to a new way of seeing. Please note: This excursion is seasonal and runs from April through October.

Extension optional excursion

Day 9: Montmartre Wine Tasting & Dinner

\$135/\$145* (5 hours, evening with dinner)

Start off your evening with a walk through Pigalle's cabaret-lined streets, passing by Moulin Rouge on the way. Then, take a funicular ride to the top of Montmartre, the highest point of the city, and explore the lively area around the iconic Sacré-Cœur Basilica. Afterward, enjoy a French wine tasting led by a local expert and a delicious three-course dinner.
