- ii) Documenting, in the "Use of Results" sections,

 - Difficulty with and/or impossibility of action plans for continuous improvement due to the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic.
- b) Assessment info for Certificate and degree programs offered 100% (Requirement of the Higher Learning Commission [HLC]):
 - i) Documentation of assessment activities for programs offered fully online
 - ii) Requirement of comparability of learning outcomes if a version of the same fully online program is also offered traditionally using the face-to-face and/or blended format.

- b) Discussions regarding criteria for assessment funding. Per proposal from the Provost's Office, going forward, assessment funding will be based on enrollment of majors in each degree program in every school/department.
