## SAMPLE COURSE SUBSTITUTIONS

### Foreign Languages Offered at OU

#### Linguistics Courses

Each student using this substitution policy must take LING/ANTH 1203, LING/ANTH 2303, LING/ANTH 3063, or COMM 2003.

### Cultural Studies

Each student must take two additional courses that portray a culture represented by the foreign languages offered at OU. Both courses must involve the study of a single culture. They do not need to be in the same department. It is important to remember that some courses may have prerequisites. Following are examples to help guide students and advisors in selecting courses for the language substitution.
