SAMPLE COURSE SUBSTITUTIONS

Foreign Languages Offered at OU

Linguistics Courses

Each student using this substitution policy must take LING/ANTH 1203, LING/ANTH 2303, LING/ANTH 3063, or COMM 2003.

Cultural Studies

Each student must take two additional courses that portray a culture represented by the foreign languages offered at OU. Both courses must involve the study of a single culture. They do not need to be in the same department. It is important to remember that some courses may have prerequisites.
