Scott Fritzen is Associate Professor, Director of International Executive Education and Director of the Global Master of Public Administration Program at the Evans School of Public Policy and Governance at the University of Washington. He previously served as Associate Provost for Academic Affairs at NYU Shanghai; as Interim Dean and Vice Dean for Academic Affairs for the Robert F. Wagner Graduate School of Public Service, NYU; and as Vice Dean for Academic Affairs of the Lee Kuan Yew School of Public Policy (LKY School, National University of Singapore). Professor Fritzen's research focuses on the comparative analysis of anti-corruption and decentralization strategies in Asia, and the globalization of public policy education. He received his Ph.D. from the Woodrow Wilson School of Public and International Affairs at Princeton in 2000.
