# **General Education Requirements**

#### **Juniors**

We understand that you will still be taking courses through Fall 2024 to meet the requirements for degree. Please use the space provided at the bottom of the first page to outline your plan for finish all major and major support requirements before the Spring 2025 semester. #### What If I Still Have Courses Left to Take During or After My BPH Semester?

As long as they are not courses for the major (includes major core, major electives, and major support), this is fine. You can finish your university and college general education requirements alongside the BPH courses, or in the Summer after the BPH semester. Just be sure your remaining courses will NOT conflict with your BPH courses.

# How do I find my GPAs?

For your Combined Retention and OU Retention GPAs, please access your unofficial transcript (available via ONE.ou.edu, under the Academics tab). Your "Total Institution" GPA is your OU Retention GPA. Your "Overall" GPA is your Combined Retention GPA.

For your major GPA, you may access Degree Navigator at degree.ou.edu, and view your audit. Toward the bottom of the audit is a box that says "Condition Requirements Summary" and it will contain your Major GPA.
