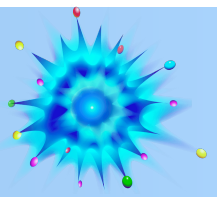
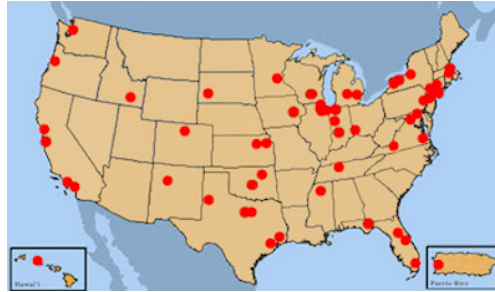


QuarkNet: Oklahoma

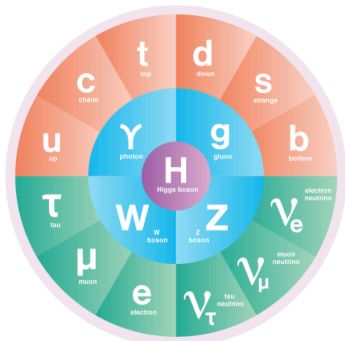
