- Health benefit allowance to significantly cover the cost of health, dental and vision plans on top of your regular salary

Minimum Qualifications:

Child Welfare Specialist, Level I - To qualify, the applicant must have 90 hours from an accredited college or university; 3 years of experience related to child welfare social work; or a combination of education and experience.

Child Welfare Specialist, Level II - To qualify, the applicant must have a bachelor's degree (in any field).

Child Welfare Specialist, Level III - To qualify, the applicant must have a master's degree, OR a bachelor's degree, and one year of professional social work experience.

Applicants who possess a Master's Degree in Social Work will be entitled to a salary incentive of an additional 5% of the base pay.
