PRACTICUM FORMAT OPTIONS &

Concentration Year Practicum is available in two formats: Spring Block and Spring Extended.
You will notify the Field Office during Practicum Orientation (takes place fall of Advanced Standing Year) which format you will be pursuing.

SPRING BLOCK

- Practicum III and IV during Spring Semester
- 35 hours per week / 550 hours total
- Practicum orientation fall semester prior to start of practicum

SPRING EXTENDED

- Practicum III during Spring Semester
- Practicum IV during Summer Semester
- 19 hours per week /
 550 hours total
- Practicum orientation fall semester prior to start of practicum
