
Engineering Study Abroad Arezzo, Italy ~ Program dates: May 13 to June 9

COURSE: ENGR 2002 – Engineering Professional Skills and Responsibilities

EVENTS AND EXPERIENCES:

<u>ARRIVAL/DEPARTURE</u>: Students will start and end their program in Venice, Italy, the City of Canals.

<u>PROGRAM BASE</u>: Arezzo, situated in the heart of Tuscany, will be our home base.





COURSE AND PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT:

Course will guide students through development and practice of non-technical aspects of engineering, critical for managing the serious responsibilities that practicing engineers and scientists face. Company visits complement the course and give students the opportunity to develop and practice professional skills through guided activities and events.

<u>CULTURAL EXPERIENCE</u>: The city of Arezzo was one of twelve Etruscan capitals and was eventually concurred by the Roman in the fourth century BC. Known for its gold and pottery, the city was founded atop a steep hill overseeing the River Arno valley against the backdrop of the Prato Magna mountains. The OU Learning Center located in the historical center offers ready access to classrooms, study halls and a computer room. Students attend corporate and cultural site visits, which fosters their understanding of Italian culture.
