

Accelerated (BS/MS) Degree Program

Application Form

Undergraduate OU students majoring in Biomedical Engineering (A108 Biomedical Engineering Standard) can apply to the Biomedical Engineering Accelerated Degree Program (A108/F109 MS Biomedical Engineering) if they have completed at least 8 hours of biomedical engineering courses. The minimum GPA (retention and combined retention) required to apply is 3.25 although a minimum GPA of 3.5 is recommended. Students must maintain a 3.25 GPA or better throughout the program. Acceptance into the Accelerated Degree Program is not a guarantee of support during the MS portion of the program. Financial support is not automatic and is on a case-by-case basis. Please visit your Biomedical Engineering faculty advisor as soon as possible to discuss the program.
