She is the author of *The Patriarchal Paradox: Women Politicians in Turkey* (1989), *Rethinking Islam and Liberal Democracy: Islamist Women in Turkish Politics* (2005), *Violence against Women in Turkey* (2007, with Ayşe Gül Altınay), and *Turkey Between Democracy and Authoritarianism* (with Şevket Pamuk) (Cambridge, 2019) as well as many academic articles.
