The Material Management warehouse at 705 officially debuted in January 2025. Since then, the team has processed over 900 special order purchase orders, 500 inventory purchase orders, 1,000 pick tickets, and 2,000 counter releases. The entire warehouse, including over 4,511 active bins, were counted at least once prior to annual inventory counts. In the last week of June, the Material Management team combined efforts with other Facilities Management team members to perform the official annual count.

Sarkey's Fitness Lighting Upgrade



The Electric Shop recently wrapped up their first summer project at the Sarkeys Fitness Center. The goal was to upgrade the lighting by replacing all of the old 400-watt metal halide lamps with energy-efficient 150-watt LED bulbs. 140 of them total. To do this, the shop removed the existing fixtures, took out the ballasts, and disposed of them in an environmentally responsible way. The system was then converted to a direct-wire setup, which will lead to significant energy savings over time.

Since the lights were located above the four south basketball courts, the shop had to rent two 40-foot man lifts to reach them. To protect the hardwood floors, the team laid down thirty sheets of ³/₄-inch plywood, carefully moving them along as the lifts were repositioned from one fixture to the next.

Thanks to the crew's hard work and coordination, the project was completed four days ahead of schedule, resulting in significant cost savings on the installation. Rod Strickland, Jonathan Harper, James Lane, and Logan Tougas all did an outstanding job getting this done safely, efficiently, and ahead of time.

There may be some questions about the FY26 Staff Merit Salary Program here are some common ones:

- 1. Where do I find my merit tier assignment for 2024? This is located on your 2024 Evaluation in Cornerstone. Just following these easy steps:
 - a. Log into OU Cornerstone websitecornerstone.ou.edu
 - b. Click on the three lines in the upper right-hand corner.
 - c. Select Profile>Annual Reviews>Click on the down arrow next to "Annual Review - CY2024>Click "Print Review."
 - d. Scroll to the last page and find your Merit Tier.
- 2. Are there specific eligibility requirements? Here is the website that includes the eligibility criteria: https://hr.ou.edu/FY2026-Staff-Merit-Salary-Program
- 3. Be sure to check your email for updates from the Central HR office regarding updates and official communications.

2025 Goal Check-in

While you're in Cornerstone, now is a great time to check-in on your 2025 goals. Here's how:

- 1. Click on the three lines in the upper right-hand corner.
- 2. Under the Performance section, select Goals.

From there, you should see your current goal period (01/01/2025 - 12/31/2025). You can click into each goal to add comments about your progress.
