### **ABOUT THE ARTIST:**

She also delves into the world of Iranian calligraphy, using it as a springboard to explore new approaches in typography and create more diverse graphical forms. This unique blend of cultural elements is a testament to Sara's artistic vision and the depth of her creative exploration.

Sara used Iranian calligraphy in abstract forms along with other abstract elements to tell a story. That story is based on her own experience and trauma paired with a life-long interest in Iranian classical literature, specifically Shahnameh and the Tale of Zahhak. This design is Sara's first step in presenting her personal interpretation of the story. Future plans for this work include use in a bigger abstract animation project.
