- -Class will visit London, Bath, Bristol, Cardiff and Windsor. The international portion of the class is 20 days.
- -Depart OKC or DFW. Return to OKC or DFW. Students may extend their time in Europe after the end of the course if they want.
- -Each student is required to enroll in 2 upper division elective 3-hour courses:

- Six pre-departure class sessions will be held during March-April 2026.
- Cost: \$3,695 which includes:
 - * Accommodations in London, Cardiff, Bristol, and Windsor
 - Local transportation in the UK including transfers from the airport and hotel and between destinations, when traveling in the group
 - * Transportation to, from and within London, Bath, Bristol, Cardiff, and Windsor
 - Closing Ceremony and Dinner
 - Various cultural excursions and field trips
- Not included in the \$3,695:
 - Tuition and Fees for two upper division classes (Note: Banked tuition hours may apply for some hours)
 - \$50 Education Abroad Fee (billed through the Bursar's office)
 - Airfare to and from the United Kingdom
 - Most meals
 - Passport costs
 - Personal Expenses
