- Member at Large status faculty appointment for Dr. Marie Dallam was unanimously approved.
- Family/Medical GA Release
  - Dean Hewes and Associate Dean Karr presented a proposed policy to allow graduate assistants to receive releases from GA duties due to a documented family or medical event but continue to make academic progress (if feasible given their situation) and maintain their tuition waiver and health insurance. A motion to

approve the 4.3.2.3 Family and Medical Graduate Assistant Release policy as circulated was unanimously approved by the Graduate Council.

- Academic standards for accelerated programs
  - Associate Dean Karr conducted an open discussion with respect to section 2.2.1.4 of the Graduate College bulletin, which covers the required minimum GPA for retention in the undergraduate portion of accelerated degree programs. The policy is not aligned with the minimum GPA requirements (updated in 2019) for standalone master's and doctoral programs. The Graduate College will work on a proposed update to section 2.2.1.4 to be discussed at a future Graduate Council meeting.
