## **Discussion Items**

- Thesis and Dissertation Errata Policy
  - Dr. Sherri Irvin presented the Graduate College Thesis and Dissertation Errata Policy. This policy will provide a mechanism and process for publishing significant corrections to previously published theses and dissertations. As outlined in the policy language, examples of acceptable corrections would be significant errors in content that are discovered after submission of the document to SHAREOK, or to

excise proprietary or confidential information. Significant errors are defined as errors in information or attributions that change the meaning of the entire thesis or dissertation or of significant portions of the document. They are not stylistic or editorial changes that would normally be made as revisions to the document prior to the thesis or dissertation defense and that do not fundamentally change the meaning of any of the content. A motion to accept the draft policy as circulated was unanimously approved by the Graduate Council.
