M2 All M1 privileges; may also serve on doctoral committees.	Doctorate or Equivalent	Same requirements as M1
M3 All M2 privileges; may also direct doctoral dissertations.	Doctorate or Equivalent	A minimum of two research publications in refereed journals or the equivalent with the past five years and rank renewable term, tenure-track or tenured in DGES
Special Member Duties as approved by Graduate Dean; maximum term is two years.	Doctorate or Equivalent	Same as M0
