
OAIP Process

Unless and until there is a final determination of misconduct, the student will be afforded the presumption of innocence. All students have the right to an advisor.

The burden is on the University to establish responsibility. Investigators determine the sufficiency of the evidence, not responsibility of misconduct.

The hearing panel is tasked with making a determination of responsibility and are bound by an evidentiary standard of "more likely than not."

An AV may appeal a total of one time while a student and a total of two times following graduation.
