



Be aware of how Al tools use your data. Ensure that any personal or sensitive information is protected.




# Adhere to Academic Integrity

Always use Al tools in a way that maintains the principles of academic honesty. Do not use Al to plagiarize, fabricate data, or cheat in exams or assignments.




#### **Avoid Bias Propagation**

Understand that AI can have biases based on the data it was trained on. Be cautious not to perpetuate these biases in your work.




#### Cite AI Assistance

If you use Al for assistance in your work, cite it as you would any other source. Transparency about the use of Al tools is crucial.




#### Use for Learning, Not Just Efficiency
