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Intro to IRR

- Responsible for creating and reporting official data about OU
 - Monitor data quality
 - Track changes to federal and state reporting definitions and requirements
 - Provide decision support to administration

Data Areas

- IRR creates and stores official data on:
 - Student enrollment and demographics
 - Degrees granted
 - Credit hours
 - Retention and graduation
 - Faculty and staff headcounts
 - Faculty salary studies



Data Areas

- IRR might access but does <u>not</u> create/ control information about:
 - Student financial aid
 - Budget/finances
 - OU Foundation
 - Research awards/expenditures
 - Development/alumni association



IRR is Responsible for:

- Providing required data to federal, state, and accrediting agencies
- Providing data for administrative processes such as Academic Program Review
- Participation in national surveys and benchmarking projects

IRR's Official Reporting Data

- We store frozen (aka "snapshot") data
 - Each snapshot is more generally referred to in our reports as a census
 - It is a saved copy of data as of a single point in time, taken according to a predetermined schedule

Why Snapshots?

- Having data frozen at specific points in time allows for point-in-time comparisons
 - Year-to-year
 - Progress at different points in semester

Census Dates

√ Official Reporting Date (ORD)

- Student data: after the add/drop period has ended; in fall/spring it is the first working day after three full weeks of classes, summer is more complicated so ORD comes later at more like the 8th or 9th week; sometimes referred to as "3rd week"
- ➤ HR data: the first working day on or after November 1st (after October payroll)



Census Dates

√ End-of-Semester (EOS)

- After all classes have ended <u>and</u> all grades have been submitted significant because Law gets 30 days to submit their grades, so there can be quite a lag between classes ending and the EOS snapshot
- Only applicable to student data
