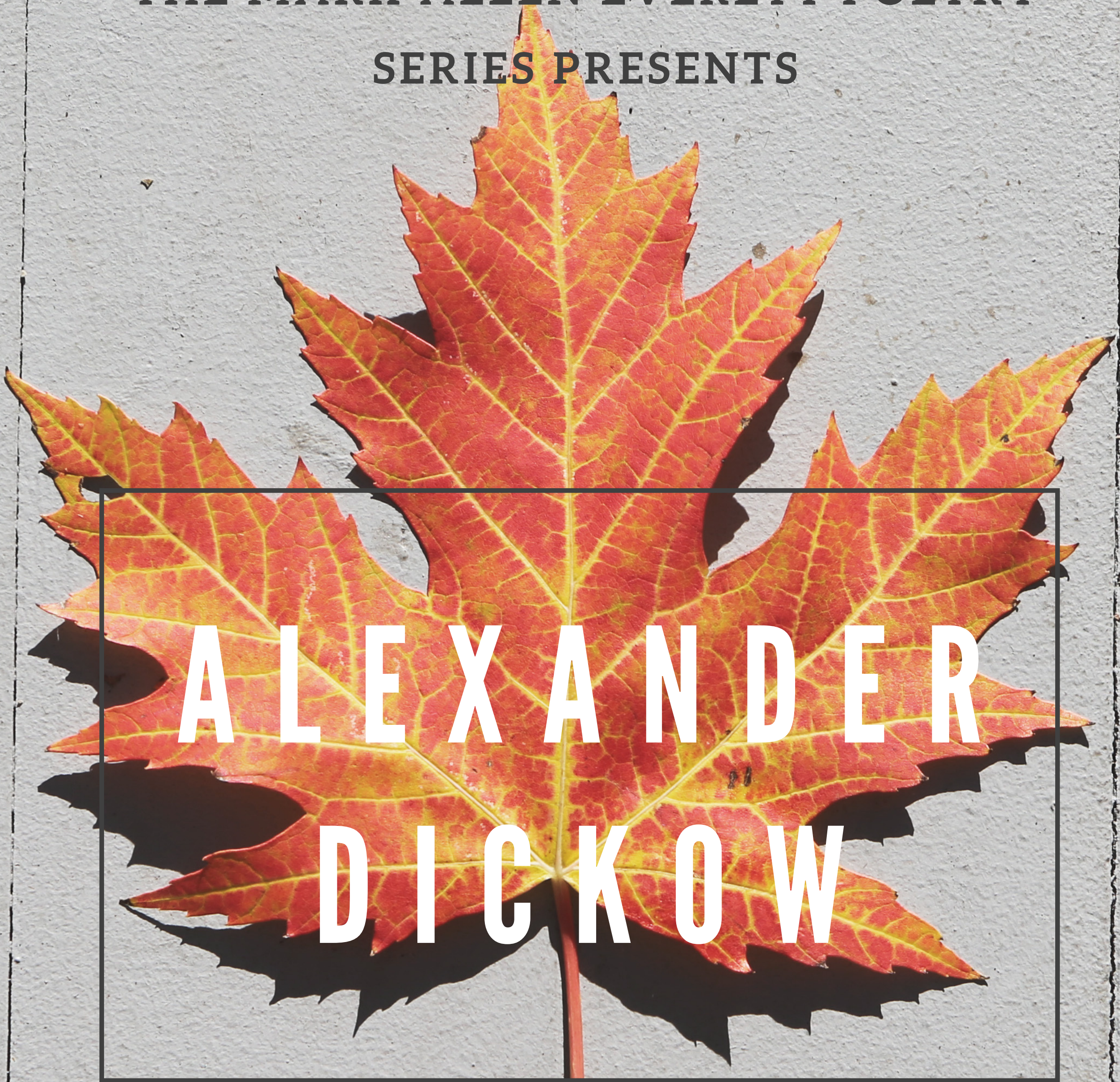

Alexander Dickow is the author of *Caramboles* (Paris: Argol Editions, 2008), a collection of poems in French and English, and *Le Poète innombrable: Blaise Cendrars, Guillaume Apollinaire, Max Jacob* (Paris: Hermann, 2015), a scholarly work. He lived in France as a Fulbright scholar in 2003-2004, and subsequently completed his cotutelle dissertation on French modernism in 2011 (Rutgers/Paris 8). He has published scholarship, poetry, and translations in dozens of journals abroad and in the US, and teaches the language, literature and culture of France and Francophone countries at Virginia Tech. Forthcoming projects include book length translations of Gustave Roud and Max Jacob, a new book of prose in French, a new collection of poetry.
