

MPGE Professional Program: What you need to know

- Admission to the Mewbourne College of Earth and Energy (MCEE) is separate from the MPGE Professional Program. Students can be in the College (MCEE) but not eligible to enroll in upper division PE courses. To be in the MCEE, you will need to complete at least 24 credit hours, including CHEM 1315 and either MATH 1823 and 2423 or MATH 1914 with a C or better, and have an OU retention and combined retention GPA of 2.5 or higher.
- The MPGE Professional Program is the ability to enroll in Upper Division (3000 and 4000 level) PE courses. Admission to the MPGE Professional Program signifies that you have the technical foundation for success in the upper level PE courses. The first set of upper division courses are offered the spring semester of the sophomore year: PE 3022 (Technical Communications), PE3213 (Reservoir Rock Properties), and PE 3221 (Rock Properties Lab).

Admission to the MPGE Professional Program is

guaranteed when:

AND

OR

- You meet the College (MCEE) Scholastic Regulations,

including a 2.50 OU GPA and 2.50 Combined GPA

- You have a 3.0 GPA in the requisite courses (if you

- You have a 3.25 GPA in the requisite courses (if you

transfer 2 or fewer requisite courses)

transfer 3 or more requisite courses).

- A strong foundation in these six (6) requisite courses is required:
 - __ MATH 1823 or 1914 Calculus I
 - __ MATH 2423 or 2924 Calculus II
 - __ CHEM 1315 General Chemistry I
 - __ CHEM 1415 General Chemistry II
 - ___ PHYS 2514 Physics for Engineers I
 - __ GEOL 1114 Physical Geology

Note: AP credit does not have a GPA weight but counts as an OU course.

You can apply as soon as you are enrolled in the **last of the requisite courses**. For most students

this means you can apply after you enroll for your fall sophomore courses (when you enroll in GEOL 1114).

How to Apply: Applications are available online at: http://www.ou.edu/content/mcee/student_services/mpgeprofessional-program.html or you can complete a paper copy in the MCEE Student Services Office in Sarkeys, first floor, room P110 (between the elevators and Bedrock Café).

Note: Students are required to complete all other prerequisites with a grade of C or better to enroll in upper division PE courses. For example: PE 3022 (Technical Communications) requires ENGL or EXPO 1213 as a prerequisite.

Application Early Review Deadlines: While applications are always accepted, applications submitted by the deadlines below will help ensure your application is reviewed prior to the start of the next semester.

- Spring Applications are due April 15th
- Summer Applications are due July 1st
- Fall Applications are due November 15th
