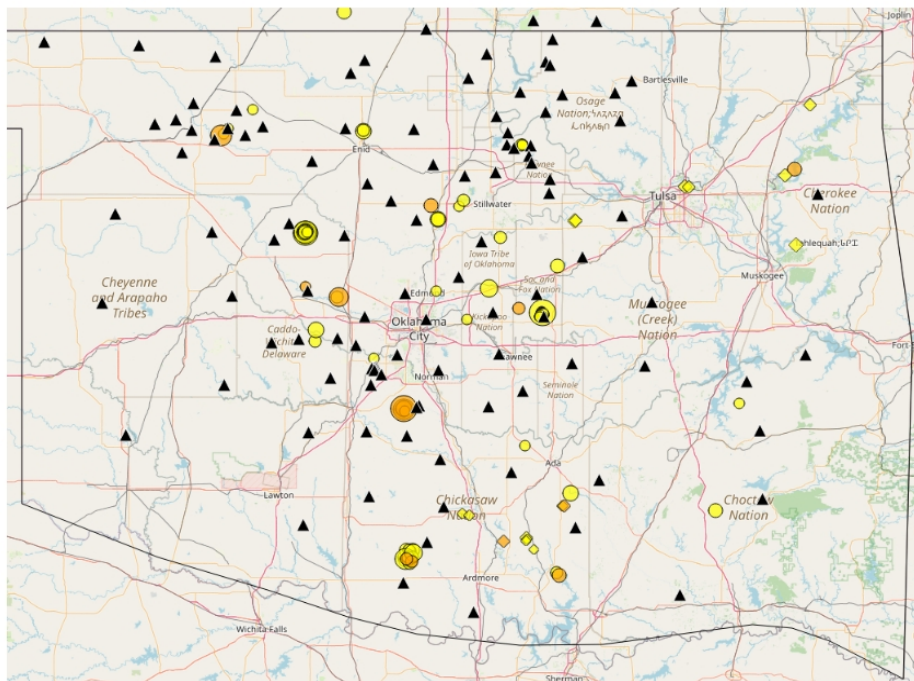




Oklahoma Seismicity Bulletin, January 2026



Snapshot of earthquake map for January 2026. Circles are earthquakes (larger circle means larger earthquake), diamonds are quarry blasts, triangles are seismic stations. There were 158 earthquakes this month in the state.

Most active counties this month:

Blaine: 48 events
Lincoln: 24 events
McClain: 14 events
Carter: 10 events
Jefferson: 8 events

Magnitude snapshot this month:

3.0-3.9: 1 event
2.0-2.9: 19 events
1.0-1.9: 114 events
0.0-0.9: 17 events
Negatives: 7

Oklahoma Seismic Network News

This month, the OGS seismic team didn't install any new stations, but did drill 11 new vaults to prepare for installs. Recent installs/upgrades were: 9 in December, 7 in November, 6 in October, 9 in September, 8 in August, and 7 in July. Some temporary stations have also been retired. This brings the total OGS station count to 146. New installs and upgrades use the newer, OGS owned equipment (not piecemeal or borrowed) and the deeper (8 foot) vault design. No more flooding pickle barrel vaults will be deployed at new installs, and we're replacing them when upgrading existing stations.
