Short-term faculty-led programs are the predominant study abroad model at OU and nationally as they create access to study abroad for students who might not be able to spend a semester or year abroad. Program leaders travel with students and teach 1-2 courses over a short period of time - as little as one week over Spring Break and typically 3-4 weeks in the summer. Most faculty-led programs are 2-4 weeks long and take place between mid-May and late July. Topics vary widely and we encourage innovative and creative proposals!

We invite you to reach out to us if you have ideas or interest in leading a potential program and would like more information on building a program proposal. We are happy to share our experience to help you find a program model, duration, location, and/or format that best serves your department.
