

#### THINGS TO KNOW

Academic counselors with knowledge of all majors help guide students on their chosen academic paths and recommend courses suitable for undecided students to explore.

Major exploration coaching helps students find majors that match their skills, interests, values, and career plans. The Majors/Minors Fair, held every spring, brings together representatives from more than 100 majors.

The First-Year Foundations (formerly Gateway to College Learning) course is designed specifically to address the needs of first-year students as they make the transition from high school to college. First-year students connect to each other and the larger OU community through small classes, intentional curriculum, and guidance from a caring instructor and peer teaching assistant.

UC Action Tutoring provides academic assistance outside of the classroom through course faculty and peer led tutoring, review sessions, and study skills development.

UC provides first-year student leadership opportunities, awards, and scholarships.

The First-Year Student Mentoring Program provides incoming students an opportunity to establish relationships with faculty and other students, explore new opportunities, and expand understanding of other cultures.

Lissa & Cy Wagner Hall is a beautiful facility for students and features state-of-the-art technology, study spaces, a welcoming atmosphere, and other student support services, such as the Writing Center and Project Threshold.
