



INTERNATIONAL SCHOLARSHIPS

FOR INTERNATIONAL FRESHMEN ENTERING FALL 2018

The University of Oklahoma offers scholarships to international students based on your completed application for admission to the university and qualified SAT or ACT exam scores. Admissible, non-US citizens attending secondary school in a country other than the United States are eligible for the scholarships listed below.

You must apply for admission by December 15 to be considered for these scholarship opportunities. Applicants may retake the SAT and/or ACT exam and send updated, official exam results to the Office of International Admissions & Recruitment through April 30, 2018. A student's highest overall score from a single exam date will be used for scholarship consideration.

The scholarships listed below are awarded on a rolling basis throughout the academic year. You will be contacted directly if you receive an award. You cannot receive more than one award from the list below, with the exception of the Legacy Award, which can be combined with any of the others.

1: SAT = Evidence Based Reading and Writing plus Math (Essay score is excluded) . Beginning in March 2016, the SAT changed its score scale. The new scale is used here. If you took the SAT before March 2016, visit link.ou.edu/satconcordance to convert your score for comparison purposes.

Award of Excellence	Partial tuition waiver over four years.	\$36,000 (\$9,000 x 4 years)	31 ACT or 1420 SAT ¹ (or greater)
Distinguished Scholar	Partial tuition waiver over four years.	\$32,000 (\$8,000 x 4 years)	29-30 ACT or 1350-1410 SAT ¹
University Scholar	Partial tuition waiver over four years.	\$28,000 (\$7,000 x 4 years)	28 ACT or 1310-1340 SAT ¹
Academic Achievement Award	Partial tuition waiver over four years.	\$24,000 (\$6,000 x 4 years)	26-27 ACT or 1240-1300 SAT ¹
Non-Resident Merit Award	Partial tuition waiver over four years.	\$16,000 (\$4,000 x 4 years)	24-25 ACT or 1160-1230 SAT ¹
Legacy Scholars Award	Partial tuition waiver for freshman year.	\$1,000	Admissible students whose parent or grandparent graduated from OU. CAN be combined with one of the other awards above.
