



NON-RESIDENT SCHOLARSHIPS

FOR FRESHMEN ENTERING FALL 2017

OU offers a variety of scholarships for admitted incoming freshmen based on criteria such as academics, leadership, community involvement, intended major, extracurricular interests, etc. Visit scholarships.ou.edu to explore other scholarship opportunities. In some cases, additional requirements such as essays, interviews, auditions and portfolios may be necessary. The list below represents general, university-centralized freshman scholarships and is not intended to be all-inclusive. Scholarship amounts are subject to change.

You must apply by December 15 to be considered for the academic and leadership/community involvement scholarships listed below. If you apply by Dec. 15, academic merit-based scholarships are awarded on a rolling basis after admission. To be considered for leadership, community involvement and some departmental scholarships, submit your application and scholarship questions by Dec. 15. You are encouraged to apply for admission and scholarships early during your senior year of high school. Please note that some scholarships may have earlier deadlines and some scholarship selection committees may begin awarding scholarships earlier. Applicants are also encouraged to retake the ACT and/or SAT through April 30 and send their seventh semester transcript for scholarship update consideration. When awarding scholarships, we will use a student's highest overall GPA and/or highest composite score from a single date on the national or residual tests taken before April 30.

ACADEMIC SCHOLARSHIPS

1: SAT = Evidence Based Reading and Writing plus Math (Essay score is excluded). Beginning in March 2016, the SAT changed its score scale. The new scale is used here. If you took the SAT before March 2016, visit link.ou.edu/satconcordance to convert your score for comparison purposes.

Awarded on a rolling basis throughout the academic year. You will be contacted directly if you receive an award. You can't receive more than one award. Please note, tuition waivers do not stack with these awards. A student will be offered the higher tuition waiver.

National Merit Scholars	Combination of state, university and National Merit funding.	\$130,000	Guaranteed to every National Merit Finalist who names OU as his/her college choice prior to May 1. Students who apply to OU after 12/15 are still eligible. See nationalmerit.ou.edu for details.
Oklahoma State Regents' Institutional Nominee	Partial tuition waiver plus cash award from state over four years. Limited number available.	\$43,200	Minimum qualifying criteria and award amount set annually by the State Regents in late fall. Students who apply by 12/15 will be considered. Award notifications are sent in the spring. See okhighered.org/academic-scholars for details.
Award of Excellence	Partial tuition waiver over four years.	\$36,000 (\$9,000 x 4 years)	31 ACT or 1420 SAT ¹ (or greater) and 3.75 GPA or top 10% class rank
Distinguished Scholar	Partial tuition waiver over four years.	\$32,000 (\$8,000 x 4 years)	29-30 ACT or 1350-1410 SAT ¹ and 3.75 GPA or top 10% class rank
University Scholar	Partial tuition waiver over four years.	\$28,000 (\$7,000 x 4 years)	28 ACT or 1310-1340 SAT ¹ and 3.5 GPA or top 10% class rank
Academic Achievement Award	Partial tuition waiver over four years.	\$24,000 (\$6,000 x 4 years)	26-27 ACT or 1240-1300 SAT ¹ and 3.5 GPA
Non-Resident Merit Award	Partial tuition waiver over four years.	\$16,000 (\$4,000 x 4 years)	24-25 ACT or 1160-1230 SAT ¹ and 3.5 GPA
Non-Resident Honor Award	Partial tuition waiver over four years.	\$16,000 (\$4,000 x 4 years)	26 ACT or 1240 SAT ¹ (or greater) and 3.25-3.49 GPA

LEADERSHIP/COMMUNITY SCHOLARSHIPS

Awarded after the Dec. 15 scholarship deadline. You will be contacted directly if you receive an award. Please note, tuition waivers do not stack with academic awards. A student will be offered the higher tuition waiver.

SCHOLARSHIP	DESCRIPTION	AMOUNT	ELIGIBILITY
President's Leadership Class	Partial tuition waiver over four years plus cash stipend. Selection highly competitive.	\$21,250 (\$5,000 x 4 years + \$1,250 cash stipend)	Based on information provided in your responses to the scholarship questions about leadership, volunteer activities and honors/awards in your application.
President's Community Scholars	Partial tuition waiver over four years plus cash stipend. Selection highly competitive.	\$20,900 (\$5,000 x 4 years + \$900 cash stipend)	Based on information provided in your responses to the scholarship questions about volunteer and community involvement, leadership and achievements in your application.
Henderson Scholars	Annual cash stipend for up to four years. Selection highly competitive.	\$10,000 (\$2,500 x 4 years)	Based on information provided in your responses to the scholarship questions about academic criteria, leadership achievements/awards, and community service in your application.

SCHOLARSHIP	DESCRIPTION	AMOUNT	ELIGIBILITY
Legacy Scholars Award	Non-resident partial tuition waiver for freshman year. May be combined with other academic-based tuition waiver.	\$1,000	Admissible non-residents whose parent or grandparent graduated from OU.
