Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education Academic Scholars Program Applicant Information for Optional Summer Awards

The Oklahoma State Regents' Academic Scholars Program policy provides optional summer term awards for students who meet the criteria outlined below. Part-time awards for enrollment of 6 to 11 credit hours made for the summer term will count as one-half of a semester used in the program and will be one-half of a semester award for the institution the student attends. Full-time awards for enrollment of 12 or more credit hours made for the summer term will count as a full semester used in the program and will be a one-semester award for the institution the student attends. The award will be disbursed to the institution on the student's behalf after the application deadline of May 17, 2024.

Eligibility for Summer 2024 Award

Students must meet the following criteria for payment purposes:

- 1. The student must have earned 24 semester credit hours during the fall 2023 and spring 2024 semesters combined. In addition, if the student was on a leave of absence for any portion of the 2023-2024 academic year, he or she will be required to have earned twelve credit hours for each semester, not on leave.
- 2. The student must be enrolled in at least six semester credit hours at a single higher education institution in Oklahoma.
- 3. The student must have been admitted to a degree-granting undergraduate, graduate, or professional program.

Application Procedure

Students who meet the above criteria should complete and sign the summer 2024 application. The application requires the signature of the Academic Scholars Program Coordinator or another institution official at the summer institution. This signature certifies that the student has earned at least 24 semester credit hours in the previous academic year and is enrolled in at least six credit hours.

The institution official must submit the completed application to the Oklahoma State Regents' office no later than May 17, 2024. *Applications received after this date will not be considered for payment.*

Continuing Eligibility for Fall 2024 Award

To be eligible for an award for the fall 2024 semester, students paid part-time for the summer term must have earned at least 30 semester credit hours for fall 2023, spring 2024, and summer 2024 terms combined. Students paid a full-time award for the summer term must have earned at least 36 semester credit hours for fall 2023, spring 2024, and summer 2024 terms combined. In addition, the student must have earned a 3.25 cumulative grade point average and be enrolled full-time for the fall 2024 semester (12 credit hours). To expedite payment of the fall award, any summer hours at a different institution must be transferred to the student's home institution as soon as possible.
